

Poster Guidelines for Smart SysTech

Please provide a small abstract (IEEE template, 1-2 pages) to be submitted as pdf file to program@smart-systech.eu with subject "Poster for Smart SysTech".

For preparation of the poster, see hints below.

Materials

- All poster materials should be provided by the author(s)
- Poster attachments will be provided by the conference desk to attach the poster materials
- Posters should be upright in A0 size (1189 mm x 841 mm /46.8" x 33.1")

Suggestions for a good poster presentation

- DO NOT use a series of power point slides as a poster
- Title of the poster should be written in large font, 36 to 60 point
- Your main topic should be in large font if it is not covered in the title
- Do not use font sizes below 18 point
- Display the highlights of your presentation in large font, 24 to 40 point. Use colour to emphasise the important points
- Figures, charts, graphs, photos, etc. are very effective when kept simple. Too much detail will obscure the main points. Use coloured ones
- It is a good idea to sequentially number your posted material, or use arrows to indicate the flow of material
- Your posted materials should be as self-explanatory as possible
- Consider that the viewers will be 2 to 3 meters away from your material and adjust the print font, charts, graphs, and figures accordingly
- Each graph, chart and text should be at least readable from a distance of 2 m
- Plan on having an Introduction/Outline and a Summary/Conclusion clearly shown on your poster
- Author(s) must be available for discussion during the poster session
